

#### ABOUT OXDENMARQ

In 2003 Dennis Marquart and Jakob Hanghøj partnered up with the ambition to create beautiful designs of high-quality vegetable-tanned leather. Out of this came OX design. The name OX was chosen as a tribute to our unique leather and the animal providing it.

The initial goal was to produce reasonably priced furniture from vegetable tanned saddle leather. Making affordable furniture from exclusive material is a core value we still pursue in everything we do

Back in the Sixties, and unlike today, a lot of the now famous Danish Design products, furniture and other products, were affordable for the middle class. That is sadly no longer the case, but at OXDENMARQ we strive hard to make affordable furniture from exclusive materials. Despite our brand name OX, we are now much more than leather. Craftsmanship is key for us in everything we do. Danish design tradition, quality materials and skilled craftsmen from Spain and Denmark are the key components in creating our unique products.

When we set out back in 2003, Dennis Marquart was already a promising designer who had won recognition throughout the world winning international design awards. Dennis studied furniture design at The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts. During his studies, he went abroad to study in China and Japan. After 6 months at the Design Academy, Tokai Daguka, in Japan, he was honoured student of the year. During his exchange period, he learned about the importance of simplicity, aesthetics and precision. Today all three are important elements in his designs and important ingredients to our design philosophy.

Our ambition is to make simple yet elegant designs with a light expression using solid materials. The O Table in marble is a perfect example of our design philosophy. A light and simple expression despite the use of solid materials. Maybe for this same reason the Danish Design Awards nominated the O Table for the "Furniture of the Year" award in 2014.

Years ago, we decided to change our brand name to OX DENMARQ. We wanted to use the name DENMARQ to emphasize that we are Danish design brand based on the Danish design tradition and that most of our furniture is produced in Denmark. However, DENMARQ not only refers to our home country, but also to co-founder and designer DENnis MARQuart. Despite the change of brand name, our philosophy to produce beautiful and affordable handmade design furniture of high quality natural materials such as 100 % vegetable tanned leather, slate, marble, wood and glass remained unchanged. Our leather is cut by hand and sown in Spain and most of our frames are handmade in-house just outside Copenhagen. If taken good care of, OX DENMARQ furniture can be passed on to the next generation.

#### CODE OF CONDUCT

Our Code of Conduct is the foundation from where we build our efforts to improve our Supply Chain and business to be more ethic and environmental friendly. The Code of Conduct outlines the requirements we put on our suppliers.

Our Suppliers Code of Conduct focus on the following principles:

- The rights of freedom of Association and collective bargaining
- Fair remuneration
- Occupational health and safety
- Special protection for young workers
- No Bonded labour
- Ethical business behaviour
- No discrimination
- Decent working hours
- No child labour
- · No precarious employment
- Protection of the environment

Currently, we only work with suppliers from the EU where it must be expected that solid institutional frameworks are in place to secure that all EU rules with respect to labour and environmental issues are respected.

The fact that our often highly specialised suppliers are working and producing our products within the EU also allows us to spend a lot of time with them and to actively contribute to secure that the production of our products is carried out in an environmentally friendly way with an emphasis on re-cycling.

As for our materials, we supply products with the following CSR related characteristics:

- 100 % produced in the EU
- Oeko-tex certified 100 % vegetable leather with no traces of heavy metals
- FSC-certified wood

Furthermore, most of our materials can be recycled – our stainless steel is 100 % recyclable - and products are made to last a lifetime in order to minimize environmental impact.

#### MATERIAI S

We are specialised in vegetable tanned leather, natural stone and metal works. However, we do have experience with and access to a much broader range of materials including silestone, laminate, textile among others.

TABLE TOPS: We offer table tops in a broad range of materials suitable for high turnover public spaces. Table tops can be developed in materials beyond our existing collection of marble, leather, wood, glass, granite and slate. We also offer extremely robust alternatives in a large variety of ceramic stones, which gives a very strong protection against traditional problems coming from acid, colouring and scratches.

LEATHER: We use high quality vegetable tanned full-grain aniline leather from Spain. Skilled craftsmen cut the leather by hand before sowing. Our leather is OEKO-TEX certified. We can also offer semi-aniline slightly pigmented leather in a large number of colours. Some leather products can also be made in recycled leather which is also OEKO-TEX certified.

FRAMES: In-house frame production with highly skilled blacksmiths provides flexibility for product development of new products or customization of existing products. The stainless steel is of the best quality and produced primarily in France. The solid brass used in most of the frames is from Italy. All powder coated frames can be produced in RAL-colours.





## SOLUTIONS

We can offer much more than a standard collection of furniture. We are specialising in custom made solutions for segments such as hotels, restaurants, offices, retail environments and more.

We design and produce in-house at our 2000 m2 workshop placed near Copenhagen. In-house production combined with strong partnerships with key suppliers facilitate a high degree of flexibility in terms of product customization and product development.

#### **CUSTOMIZATION**

Below you see the Strap chair family, which is based on the idea of eliminating waste in leather chair production by using small leftover pieces. On the basis of this idea, the two Dining Chairs were designed.

A few years later, the Strap Bar Chair was developed for a restaurant project – a counter chair with a massive and comfortable body placed on a seemingly fragile frame. It has been said that the design leads the mind to think of Salvador Dali's master pieces of elephants with long thin legs.

The latest member of the family, the Strap Lounge chair was developed for the 2019 opening of the Luxury Boutique Hotel Ottilia in the Carlsberg City part of Copenhagen.

The Large Deck Table and Single Deck Puff were both developed for specific hotel projects.


The Deck product range can be customized in many ways in terms dimensions, colours and top materials. It is also possible to install squared tops instead of round tops.






